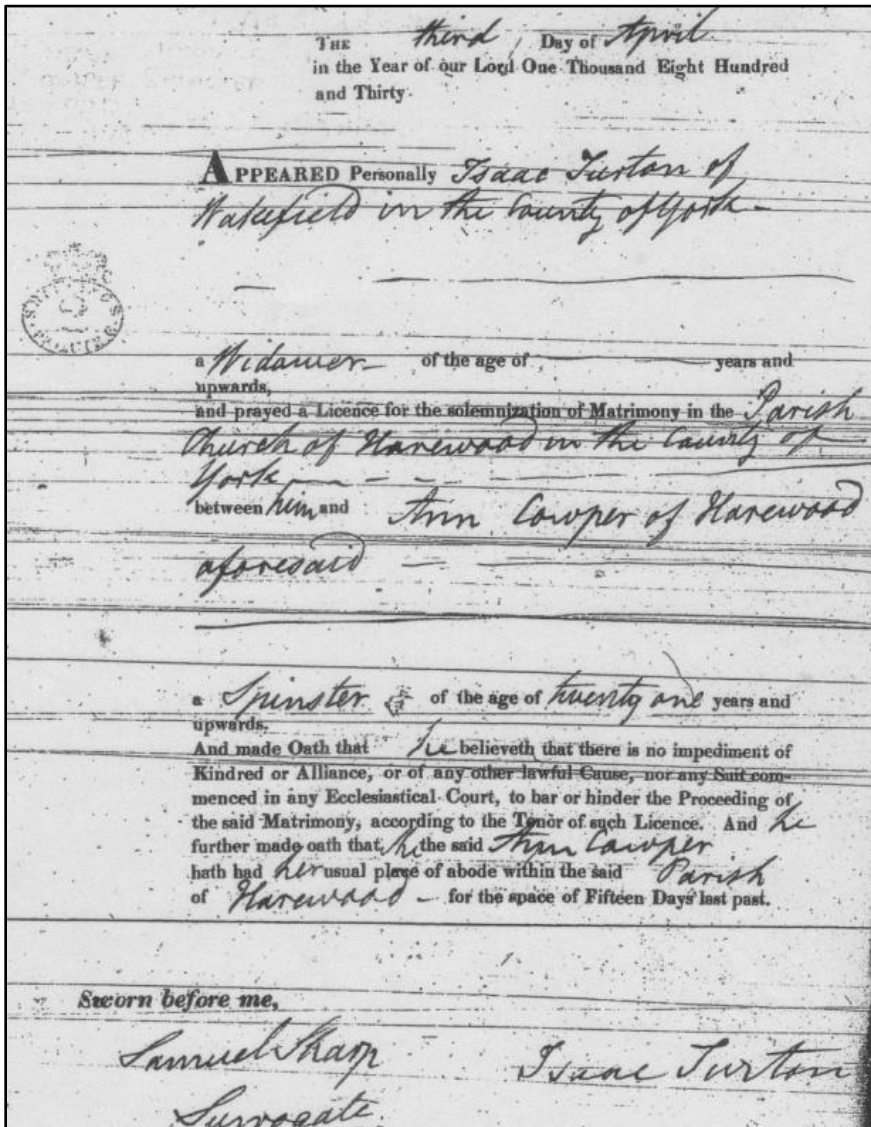


ISAAC TURTON

1777 - 1851

In 1829, Isaac now a widower, moved to Wakefield and here, he met Ann Cowper, a twenty-one year old spinster. They were married April 3rd 1830 in the Parish Church of Harewood, Yorkshire. ⁱ



Isaac and Ann moved to Selby in 1831 where their first child was born, a son they named Robert Cowper and he was baptized on August 14th 1831.

The family moved back to Bradford in 1832 and a second child was born to them, this time a daughter whom they christened Hannah on June 23rd 1833. Unfortunately, Hannah was not strong and died in July of 1833. Ann died shortly thereafter, causing Isaac to suffer the double loss of both, wife, and his daughter.
